ALTERNATIVE COMPLIANCE DECISIONS READ WITH SITE SPECIFIC CONDITIONS - APPENDIX A

Mandatory Standard 4.2

Every building must be designed and constructed in such a way that:

Provisions on which dispensation is given

in non-domestic buildings, safe, unassisted and convenient means of access is provided throughout the building

Limitation:

There is no requirement to provide access for a wheelchair user:

in a non-domestic building not served by a lift, to a room, intended to be used as a bedroom, that is not on an entrance storey, or

Basis for acceptance of alternative approach

Proposal is to be provide a single height counter at 850mm height. Design also includes for knee recess space to accommodate wheelchair users.

Site Specific Condition

While not fully meeting the specific wording of Guidance Clause 4.2.10, the proposals do take cognisance of fast food counters to fast food server areas in line with: British Standards BS8300 - 2: 2018 Design of an accessible and inclusive built environment - Part 2: Buildings - Code of Practice.

The relevant clause is 20.6 Recommendations

Refreshment buildings, including public houses, restaurants and cafes

Guidance Clause

4.2.10 Fixed counter installations at service points

Fixed counter installations such as a reception desk or a serving counter in a bar or restaurant should be accessible to a person who is standing, regardless of stature, or seated in a wheelchair.

To allow this, surfaces should be provided at two levels. For standing users, this should be within a range of 950 mm to 1.1m in height. For seated users, this should be approximately 750 mm above floor level, with a knee recess below of at least 500 mm deep and at least 700 mm high and a clear manoeuvring space in front of the surface of at least 1.2 m deep. The knee recess is particularly important where activities such as writing may take place, such as at a bank counter. Where depth of the surface will permit, the knee recess should be provided to both sides of the counter.

Where only one such counter is proposed a portion of the surface, not less than 900 mm wide or, where practical in larger installations, 1.5 m wide, should be installed at lower height. Where a number of similar counters are proposed, at least one counter should be installed at the lower height.

Where space permits (e.g. recoption or interview counters), a width of 1800 mm should be provided, to allow for two whechchair sears to be positioned alse by side or fixing each other across the counter diagnosity [see Equiti 22.6]. LIMITATIONS OF USE: ACCESSIBILITY AND MANOEUVRING SPACE

Counter height - 850mm

Having regard to the nature of the business (i.e. hot/cold food takeaway), the height of the fixed counter for standing and seated users will be 850mm.: Reason for decision There is knee space underneath the counter, height 790mm AFL (above floor level) and 300mm deep, available for wheelchair users collecting their tray from the counter.

Counter depth - 830mm: Reason for Decision The overall depth of the counter is 830mm which includes a service width of 618mm but with card terminals located within 210mm . This dimension is within the 310mm reach limit for extended reach for wheelchair users.

Circulation space -1200mm minimum [to front): Reason for Decision 6681-SA-8034-A850C1 Order & Collect Counter Details Sheet 1 of 2 indicates that a dimension of 1200mm to the front of the order and collect units would be provided. This design aspect should be checked during site-specific assessments.

Testing and Accreditation

That the counters shall be manufactured and installed strictly in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
