#### **Description of Product**

ARC Curtain Wall Barrier (3 Hours Fire Integrity) is a curtain walling fire barrier capable of achieving 3 hours fire integrity.

#### Validity

This certificate was first issued on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2011 and is valid until 28<sup>th</sup> November 2021 Issue Dated 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018



### Scope of Registration

This Registered Solution relates to the ARC Curtain Wall Barrier, designed to provide a smoke and fire barrier where curtain wall cladding systems are used with up to 3 hours fire integrity.

Limitations of use apply and are detailed on the attached Drawing and Document list.

#### For Scotland purposes:

The ARC Curtain Wall Barrier has been designed to provide a 3-hour fire barrier in an external curtain wall situation. The barrier is impaled on to the ARC insulation spike which has been installed onto the outside of the internal leaf. The barrier does not require a compression fit but is required to have a snug fit within the cavity space. Any site inaccuracies or deflection need to be sealed with a suitable intumescent sealer.

### Conditions of Certificate

To be designed and installed in accordance with ARC Curtain Wall Datasheet V1.1 11.06.2012.

Suitable for cavities up to 300mm.

For Scotland purposes:

The specifications and materials referred to have been assessed in accordance with the Building (Scotland) Regulations 2004 and in accordance with the supporting guidance in the Domestic Technical Handbooks which came into force with effect from 1 July 2017.
