Description of product

This Registered Detail is in respect of a fixed counter installation at service points to allow use by wheelchair users

Key factors assessed

- Safety in Use
- Durability serviceability and identification

Validity

This certificate was first issued on 7 April 2014 and remains valid and incorporated under STAS Approval No. STAS/17/081/ND24/01 issued on 1 October 2018.

Scope of registration

This registration relates to fixed counter installations at service points to allow use by wheelchair users.

LIMITATIONS OF USE: ACCESSIBILITY AND MANOEUVRING SPACE

Single till pod:

Having regard to the nature of the business (i.e. hot/cold food takeaway), the height of the fixed counter for standing and seated users will be 750mm for a width of 600mm.

Double till pod:

Having regard to the nature of the business (i.e. hot/cold food takeaway), the height of the fixed counter for standing and seated users will be 750mm for a width of 1100mm.

Testing and Accreditation

That the till pods shall be manufactured and installed strictly in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and in accordance with the Registered Detail holder's instructions.

Site Specific Assessment

The site specific characteristics shall be assessed by the verifier and approval granted only if the location of the till pod does not prevent access by a person in a wheelchair when using the service point side-on.

That the relevant guidance clause, 4.2.10, is taken cognisance of in utilising a counter design, that adopts the design guidance provide by the relevant clauses of BS 8300: 2001- see Annex A to this Registered Detail.

Conditions of certificate

That the specifications and materials referred to have been assessed in accordance with the Building (Scotland) Regulations 2004 and in accordance with the supporting guidance in the Domestic Technical Handbooks which came into force with effect from 1 October 2019.

That where reference is made on a plan or specification document to any Code of Practice, British or European Standard or manufacturer's instruction it shall be construed as a reference to such publication in the form in which it is in force at the date of this Registered Detail.

That the layout plan details and the materials specified shall be for purposes of specifying an alternative means of compliance under this Registered Detail and should not be changed without first gaining approval so to do from Local Authority Building Standards Scotland [LABSS]. Failure to do so will invalidate the Registered Detail.

This Registered Detail should not be regarded as a formal approval under the building warrant process prescribed by the Building (Scotland) Act 2003 enacted from 1 May 2005

That this Registered Detail shall contribute to compliance with relevant Mandatory Standards specified under the Building (Scotland) Regulations 2004 as amended when read with the scope, conditions and regulations sections to this Registered Detail.

Regulations

LABSS consider that, fixed counter installation at service points to allow use by wheelchair users, will meet the functional requirements of the Building Regulations (listed below) if the criteria detailed in this certificate are met;

The Building (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (as amended) Alternative Means of Compliance of Mandatory Standard 4.2 Access within buildings

Every building must be designed and constructed in such a way that: in non-domestic buildings, safe, unassisted and convenient means of access is provided throughout the building

Guidance Clause 4.2.10
